NEW CLERK: Leslie Doane, our elected clerk abruptly resigned at our April meeting. The board interviewed and hired Charisse Sutliff to fill the term of office. During this resignation it resulted in difficulty getting passwords and general information needed to fulfill the responsibilities of the clerk. We now have all the correspondence to the clerk come to the town hall and the computer is located at the hall. We are optimistic this will result in better serving our constituents in the future. The appointment of Sutliff and her experience will assist in making the town more receptive to our constituents in the future.

APPOINTED CLERK: At the annual meeting, it was voted to appoint a clerk at the end of this term. The board then will appoint a person for a three year period. There will no longer be an elected clerk. This will result in continuity in the position for the town's residents. The treasurer will continue to be elected.

2020 SUMMER ROAD MAINTENANCE: 390th St. will be fog sealed and repainted. We are seal coating over 7 miles of road totaling \$150,661.00. We hope to finish the last half mile of North Line Road (700th Ave.) but waiting for Xcel to move back the power line. Some of the other expenses will be for grader patching, crack sealing spray patching and town hall parking lot. We expect to spend over \$300,000.00 in road maintenance.

ANIMAL CONTROL: Please keep your pets on your property. Pick up after them. **Wild and stray cats may be live trapped and taken to the Humane Society.** We do not pick up dogs or cats. If you capture one you may take it to the Humane Society stating you are from the Town of Menomonie. **The Sheriff's Department will pick up captured dogs in some cases.**

FIRE CALLS/AMBULANCE CALLS: The town is part of the fire district and residents have to pay the first \$500.00 of a fire call. The town contracts for services from the City of Menomonie Ambulance to have it available for our residents. All ambulance calls have to be paid for by the receiver of the service.

ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAYS: The town's right-a-way is 33 feet from the center of the roadway with exceptions on 390th St at 40 feet from center of road. Contact the chairman before any planting or use of these areas.

COUNTY ZONING: We are under county zoning so before building anything contact their office or the chairman to see if you need their services. Also note any building needs a permit from the town. All new driveway accesses need a permit.

RESIDENT ADDRESSES: County zoning mandates that all residents must maintain an address number. If you need a replacement we can order one for you. The costs is around \$45.00. This expense is on the landowner.

FIBER OPTIC: The town contributed monies to further extend fiber optic to our residents. 24-7 applied for and obtained a grant which included Town of Sherman to extend fiber optic North on STH 25 and CTH FJ.

DUNN COUNTY SOLID WASTE: The program is having financial difficulties and in order to keep the program solvent expect a substantial assessment increase in 2021.

ELECTION SAFETY: The town provides for the upmost safety for in person voting, providing shields for our election workers and promoting voters to wear face masks. We maintain safe distance for those that do in person voting.

ABSENTEE VOTING: To obtain a ballot for absentee voting go online to www.myvote.wi.gov Our public test on the equipment will be held on 08-03-2020 at 10 AM. In person voting is on Tuesday August 11th 2020 7:00 AM – 8:00 PM.

BOARD MEETING DATES-TEMPORARY CHANGE: The Board meeting is normally on the 2nd Tuesday of each month but August/September meetings will be Wednesday August 12th 6:00 PM and Tuesday September 15th 6:00 PM.
